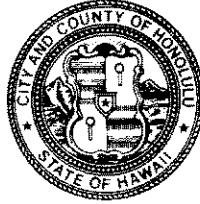

NOTICE

Beginning January 13, 2003, Waimanalo Gulch Sanitary Landfill will not accept loads with any amount of **green waste or construction and demolition (C&D) debris**. These materials, previously restricted to a maximum of 10% of a mixed load, now join **white goods, scrap metals, and automobile batteries and tires** on the list of totally banned items; **cardboard** is still restricted to 10%. Conserving the City's landfill capacity makes it imperative that these materials be recycled or disposed of at the alternative commercial facilities listed below.

Commercial and government loads to Waimanalo Gulch, H-POWER, and City transfer stations will be inspected. Trucks delivering banned materials will be denied access to City facilities for up to two weeks.
