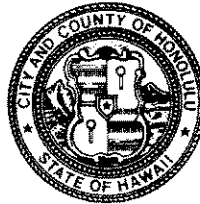

KEEHI TRANSFER STATION RULES FOR PUBLIC USE

Keehi Transfer Station, located at 606 Middle Street, accepts combustible rubbish and green waste (grass, leaves and yard trimmings) from householders between the hours of 12:00 noon and 6:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday. Access to the transfer station is via the roadway across Pineridge Trucking Company. Follow the roadway into the transfer station. Turn right immediately past the gate and proceed up the ramp to the transfer station. **Proceed with caution, observe all signs and follow instructions from ramp personnel.**

Householders are restricted to two (2) loads per day in small-size vehicles, such as pickup trucks (3/4-ton maximum), mini-vans or automobiles. Please assist us in preparing your loads by separating your green waste from other combustible material so that your green waste can be unloaded in an area designated for green waste only.

MATERIALS ACCEPTED AT KEEHI TRANSFER STATION:

Paper, cardboard, cloth, plastic
Household trash
Wood (4 x 4 or smaller, 4' long or less)
Roofing material (wood shingles and asphalt paper)
Grass and leaves
Hedge and tree trimmings (9" diameter or smaller; 4' long or less)
Used automobile batteries

MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED AT KEEHI TRANSFER STATION:

(Call Bulky Item Pickup at 523-4685 or 523-4424 to dispose of these items or haul directly to Waimanalo Gulch Sanitary Landfill in Nanakuli.)

Furniture, bed frames, mattresses and cushions
Small and large appliances
Tires
Rugs and carpeting
Tree stumps (larger than 9" in diameter)
Wood (larger than 4 x 4)
Drywall, plywood panels
Roofing materials (tile)
Dirt, rock, sand, concrete, asphalt

IF YOU HAVE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS SUCH AS:

Paint, solvents
Poisons, herbicides and insecticides
