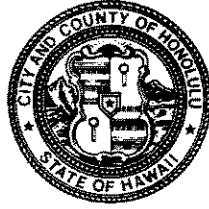

**NOTICE
TO
CONTRACTORS AND COMMERCIAL WASTE HAULERS**

Ferrous (iron) scrap metal has been banned since October 1, 1994, and construction and demolition (C&D) debris has been restricted to no more than 10% of a load since May 1, 1998, at City disposal facilities. Recent monitoring by Refuse Division staff has identified excess quantities of **metals, treated/untreated wood, gypsum wallboard, asphalt paving, soil, concrete, and porcelain/ceramics** being delivered to Waimanalo Gulch Sanitary Landfill. You and your customers should make greater use of the following recycling/disposal options.

Although the City is exploring the possibility of expanding Waimanalo Gulch, more needs to be done to divert noncombustibles from the landfill and extend its remaining capacity. No enforcement steps were taken after the recent monitoring; however, continual violations of the bans and restrictions could result in denial of landfill access to your company.
