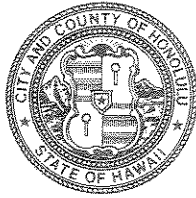

NOTICE TO HAULERS

Your compliance with the anti-litter provisions of the Traffic Code (Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes) by making it standard practice to cover your load will greatly reduce the amount of litter along our roadways, especially along H-1 Freeway and Farrington Highway. Recent monitoring of Farrington Highway showed that windblown litter escaping from "empty" trucks leaving Waimanalo Gulch Sanitary Landfill with their covers open continues to be a problem. The law also applies to this situation, and we remind you to:

- Ensure that your truck is completely emptied of rubbish at the site, and spend a few minutes sweeping it out, if necessary; **and/or**
- Reinstall the cover before leaving the plant.

Your cooperation will help keep the approaches to all disposal facilities clean, and it will ensure you avoid police citations and loss of your disposal privileges.
