

The City plans to install 1000 HI-5 recycling bins in 2013. *Want to help?*



- Do you need to complete a service-learning or senior project at school?
- Are you part of a community group that wants to do good in your neighborhood?
- Just think recycling is cool and you want to help?

These self-servicing baskets are easy to make and can be attached to existing trash containers at beaches, parks, bus stops and along sidewalks. People can deposit or withdraw HI-5 containers freely — "Take, Leave, Whatevas…"

Fabrication of the bins requires hand strength and coordination, so we are looking for students of high school age or adults to help on this project.

What you do:

- You and your group commit to making and placing 50-200 recycling bins
- Complete a bin-making workshop
- Install the bins at beaches, parks and bus stops around the island (we'll help you decide where)
- Document your work on a web-based map that will show where all the bins are located on Oahu (easy)

What you get:

- Workshops to train your group how to make the bins
- Materials and signage (groups provide basic tools)
- Storage space for completed bins, if needed
- Help with planning, technical assistance and any other assistance along the way
- Recognition as a City & County partner in this project
