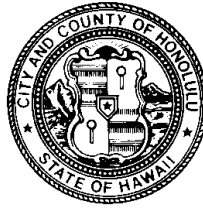

NOTICE TO LANDFILL USERS

Effective March 20, 2017, the City will limit householder use of the Waimanalo Gulch Sanitary Landfill.

- Combustible waste or bulky items will be directed to the nearest convenience center (Ewa, Laie, Wahiawa, Waianae Waimanalo and Waipahu), or transfer station (Kapaa, Kawailoa and Keehi).
- Small quantities of inert materials (e.g. dirt, rock, sand, gravel, concrete) or dead animals will be accepted at the landfill as follows:
 - Maximum 2 loads per day, 4 loads per week.
 - A vehicle hauling a full trailer will be counted as 2 loads.
- Householder vehicles are limited to sedans, pickup trucks and minivans. Large vehicles (i.e. cargo vans, box trucks and flat beds) or vehicles with commercial plates or signage are considered commercial, not householder, vehicles.
- Household users using commercial vehicles and/or hauling large quantities of inert materials or construction and demolition (C&D) waste will be directed to PVT Landfill, Nanakuli (668-4561).
