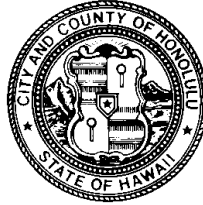

MAY 2021- H-POWER SCHEDULED MAINTENANCE DIVERSION  
VIOLATIONS OF THE POLICIES COULD RESULT IN REFUSAL OF SERVICE

- **OBEY SPEED LIMIT SIGNS – 15 MPH.**
  
- **MAINTAIN SAFE DISTANCES FROM PEOPLE, VEHICLES, AND OTHER EQUIPMENT:**
  - **STAY AT LEAST 15 FEET AWAY FROM OTHER TRUCKS THAT ARE ACTIVELY DUMPING.**
  - **STAY WITHIN 6 FEET OF YOUR TRUCK.**
  - **EVERYONE MUST BE INSIDE CAB (RIDING OUTSIDE IS NOT ALLOWED).**
  - **ONLY ONE PERSON ALLOWED OUTSIDE VEHICLE TO ASSIST DUMPING PROCESS.**
  
- **PPE REQUIREMENTS:**
  - **HARD HAT**
  - **REFLECTIVE VEST/CLOTHING**
  - **CLOSED TOED SHOES (STEEL TOED RECOMMENDED)**
  - **LONG PANTS**
  
- **NO MOBILE DEVICE USAGE IN ACTIVE AREA/TIPPING FLOOR/CLEAN OUT AREA.**
  
- **ALL USERS MUST USE PORTABLE TOILETS.**
